Recruitment Season in Full Swing

The recruitment season for Inside Running Recruitment is now in full swing with UK and European clubs starting to sign players. There has definitely been a bit of a shift in the market this year so we thought we would take the opportunity to outline what we have seen so far:

- **Professional deals are very hard to come by.** There are many factors that are influencing this, such as the economic recession; reduction of clubs at National 1 level in England; an excess of players on the market (especially in the UK); new foreign player regulations in France; some Japanese clubs not recruiting at all, etc.
- **Semi-pro and amateur clubs are offering less.** Without a doubt your standard UK club that recruits a few players each year are offering less this season. What this means for players is that they really need to revise their expectations if they are going to pick up a deal this season. Basically, what clubs have offered in the past, or what players have heard their mates getting in the past is now irrelevant in this market.
- **Semi-pro and amateur clubs are being more specific.** Clubs at these levels are really being a lot more specific in terms of what they are looking for. This is largely driven by the fact that money is a lot tighter so they are just looking to spend it in certain areas. Key demand positions are prop, lock and 10, with the

vast majority of clubs only looking to recruit in these positions. Unfortunately if you are a hooker, flanker or halfback, deals are very hard to come by this year.

- **Visas.** The Youth Mobility visa (which has replaced the UK working holiday visa) and seems to be taking 4–6 weeks to process and we haven't had any issues as yet with players having visas declined. We have a partnership with FastrackUK who complete the applications for our players and they have already pre-warned us that August is the peak season for applications and that during that period the visas may take longer than 6 weeks. Clubs and players alike should bear this in mind. We are advising all players to apply now if they wish to take up contracts in the UK this season.

We trust that this gives our clients a good feel in terms of where the market is at the moment. Whilst it might seem quite a negative update, we are still confident of achieving the same number of placements as previous years.

It is now just a case of clubs being more selective — and rightly so. ▶▶▶
